Prohibition on redisclosure: This information which has been disclosed to you from confidential records may be protected by federal law. Federal regulations (42 CFR part 2) prohibit you from making any further disclosure of this information except with the specific written consent of the person to whom it pertains. A general authorization for the release of medical or other information if held by another party may not be sufficient for this purpose. Federal regulations state that any person who violates any provision of this law shall be fined not more than \$500, in the case of a first offense, and not more than \$5,000 in case of each subsequent offense.
